Grower Of The Year Award

Reserved for members of the Wisconsin & Upper Michigan Florists' Association who have done an outstanding job of growing, distributing, new methods of production and service to retailers as well as services to the community and industry activity.

Special Services Award

Organizational activity, research or education, retailer, wholesale distributor or allied tradesman. The award might be made to those in these categories for their contribution to the industry and/or the association.

Wholesaler/Tradesman Of The Year Award

"Praemium Ad Excellentem Laborem" ... In recognition and appreciation of the unselfish labor and achievement for the advancement of the floricultural industry within the boundaries of Wisconsin and Upper Michigan.

Young Person Of The Year Award

Anyone connected with the floriculture industry—retailer, wholesaler, grower, allied tradesman or trade organization member—for meritorious service to the floral industry, community, and potential service to the industry and community in the future. Age limit: 35 years with two years in the floral industry.

National Service Award

Anyone connected with the floriculture industry—retailer, wholesaler, growers, education, plant breeder, etc.—for outstanding service to the florists industry of America.
